

Cased Goods

LOADING METHOD FOR CASED GOODS (88 UNITS) IN 60' BOXCARS



- 1. PALLETS MUST BE SOUND NO SPLIT BOARDS OR NAILS PROTRUDING, WHILE USING CORNER POSTS TO SUPPORT UPPER PALLETS.
- 2. USE CORNER POSTS & ROPING STRETCH FILM TO HELP MAINTAIN UNIT INTEGRITY, COMBINATION OF UNIT LAYERS MUST NOT BE EXCESSIVE IN OVERALL HEIGHT TO CREATE OVERHEAD WEIGHT DAMAGE TO BOTTOM LAYER PRODUCT AND MUST REMAIN BELOW THE RAILCAR'S CENTER OF GRAVITY LINE.
- 3. DID LEVEL (4) AIR BAG PER ROW IN DOORWAY SHOULD BE PROPERLY BUFFERED & INFLATED TO MIN. 3-4 PSI USE DOUBLE SIDED TAPE TO PREVENT IN-TRANSIT DISPLACEMENT.
- 4. CONSIDER USING 3/8" THICK DOUBLE-WALL PANELS TO FACE OFF (BULKHEAD PANELS) AT CHANGE IN ROW ALIGNMENT & ON PALLET SIDES OF BUFFER PANELS FOR AIR BAGS.
